Before purchasing your Grad Nite ticket you must bring with you the following:

- Current CVHS Photo School ID
- California PTA Parent's Approval and Student Waiver
- CVHS Student Permission Slip
- TERMS & CONDITIONS AND LIABILITY WAIVER
- SPECIAL NEEDS & MEDICATION FORM (if applicable)
- Cash or Check (make checks payable to CVHS PTSA)
- Guest Pass, if applicable. Must be signed by an Administrator of the Guest's school, including their CVHS/PTSA/Student Contract, signed medical/liability release form and Parent's Approval and Student Waiver form. Must also include a copy of guest's current photo school ID.

Please remind your guest that they must have their current Photo ID with them when they board the bus to leave for Disneyland and California Adventure and they must adhere to all the same requirements as CVHS students.

Tickets will not be sold to anyone without a current CVHS photo school ID, unless purchasing for a guest with required paperwork. The ID must match the person purchasing the ticket.

2017 GRAD NIGHT GENERAL INFORMATION

We congratulate YOU, a 2017 Graduate of Citrus Valley High School, and we hope your Grad Nite will be a memorable and positive experience.

TICKET SALE DATES AND PRICES: Tickets will go on sale during lunch on March 27th, 2017. Ticket prices will be \$115 per ticket from March 27-March 31. Ticket prices will increase to \$120 per ticket from April 3-7. Tickets will only be sold in the quad area during lunch. The deadline to obtain your ticket is Friday, April 7th, 2017. Ticket price includes admission into Disneyland and California Adventure, and bussing to and from the event. Students will need to bring their own money for meals and any other items they wish to purchase.

GUEST POLICY: Seniors are allowed to bring one (1) paid guest, however the guest must be at least a Senior and under the age of 20 and they must complete all the forms provided in Guest Pass Packet or they will not be allowed to purchase a ticket. Guests must adhere to all rules set forth in the packet.

TRIP INFORMATION: Grads will meet in the CVHS Bistro parking lot at 10:30am on Saturday, June 3rd, with a photo ID and their ticket, to board the buses. Buses will depart promptly at 11:00 am on Saturday, June 3rd. The buses will not wait for any Grad, no exceptions. Grad will have access to Disneyland and California Adventure Parks from park open until 9:00 pm. Grads will then meet in front of California Adventure to get in line for entrance to Grad Nite 2017, held between 10:00 pm to 2:00 am, where they will participate in a Grad-only party. At 2:00 am, Grads will head to the trams, which will **take** them to the buses. Buses will depart Disney promptly at 3:00am. Any Grad not on the bus will need to find their own transportation home. Buses will arrive at the CVHS Bistro parking lot at approximately 5:00 am on Sunday, June 4th, 2017.

SPECIAL NEEDS/MEDICATIONS: If you are a senior with special needs or one who will need medication during the trip, please let us know so we can make the appropriate accommodations. A Parent/Guardian will need to complete the Special Needs and Medication Form. This includes any over-the-counter medications. Disneyland will confiscate all medications not on an approved list upon entry into the park.

DRESS CODE: The Disneyland Dress code information is included in this packet. The Grad Night Committee assumes no responsibility for any Grad not meeting the dress code and being denied admittance to the Parks.

REGISTRATION, PERMISSION FORMS & WAIVERS: All Grads are **REQUIRED** to submit full payment and forms when purchasing their ticket. **NO GRAD WILL BE ALLOWED TO TRAVEL WITHOUT THE APPROPRIATE SIGNED FORMS.**

NON-SCHOOL SPONSORED: This is not a school-sponsored event. Neither Redlands Unified School District nor Citrus Valley High School are in any way sponsors of this trip.

CHAPERONES: This is a chaperoned event. Neither the Grad Night Committee nor the Chaperones will be responsible for any lost or stolen personal items that are brought on the trip such as cell phones, electronic devices, personal items, etc.

BUS CHOICE: Based on available seating on the buses, the Grad Night Committee will attempt to grant your choice of bus. This, however, cannot be guaranteed.

DISNEYLAND® STUDENT INFORMATION

The Disneyland® Dress Code Guidelines and Prohibited Items are listed below. Anyone not adhering to the Disneyland® Resort Dress Code Guidelines or Prohibited Items list **will be delayed and/or denied admission** to the event.

- Students must arrive together with their chaperones and group.
- Students may not arrive in student-driven vehicles under any circumstance. No exceptions.
- Once Grad Nite tickets are distributed by your chaperones, please have your individual ticket in hand as you come through our backstage security screening.
- Upon successful completion of the backstage security screening, a Main Entrance Cast Member will place a wristband on your wrist.
- **Do not lose** the wristband or Park ticket for the duration of the mix-in Park hours and the Grad Nite private event. This wristband identifies that you are able to stay for the Grad Nite private event.
- A Grad Nite Cast Member will be available at the West Esplanade Information Booth (located outside the Park Guest screening tents) 1:00 p.m.–10:00 p.m. should you need to get a hold of your chaperone.
- During the Grad Nite private event 10:00 p.m.–2:00 a.m., students who need to contact a chaperone may stop by Chamber of Commerce on Buena Vista Street inside Disney California Adventure® Park and speak with a Guest Relations Cast Member who will contact a chaperone from the school.

DISNEYLAND® DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

The Disneyland® Resort Dress Code Guidelines and Prohibited Items list have been established to ensure a safe event for all our Guests. It is ultimately the school's responsibility to ensure that all students and chaperones adhere to the Disneyland® Resort Dress Code Guidelines upon arrival.

Attire that is not appropriate for the Theme Parks (and which may result in refusal of admittance or ejection) includes, but is not limited to:

- Costumes worn by Guests 14 years of age or older
- Masks worn by Guests 14 years of age or older (unless they are for medical purposes)
- Clothing with objectionable material, including obscene language or graphics
- Excessively torn clothing or loose fitting clothing which may drag on the ground and create a potential trip hazard
- Clothing which, by nature, exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment
- Clothing with multiple layers that is subject to search upon entry
- Visible tattoos that could be considered inappropriate, such as those containing objectionable language or designs
- Bare feet

Exception: Attire intended to identify those wearing it is acceptable (e.g., military uniforms, cultural attire)

Disneyland® Resort Security has the right to refuse admission to anyone it deems inappropriately dressed.

DISNEYLAND® RESORT GRAD NITE PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST

To make sure things run smoothly, we'll be searching everyone and their belongings before entering the bus and Disneyland will be searching everyone and their belongings before entering the Park so here are the things that need to be left at home.

- **Pets**
- **Wagons**
- **Skateboards**
- **Scooters** (motorized and non-motorized)
- **Inline skates**
- **Shoes with built-in wheels**
- **Pogo sticks**
- **Suitcases**, backpacks or similar bags with wheels
- **Suitcases**, backpacks or similar bags larger than 18" wide x 25" high x 37" deep (the size of our large rentable lockers)
- **Coolers** larger than 6-pack-sized are not permitted into the Theme Parks.
- **Alcoholic beverages**
- **Any illegal substances**
- **Over-the-counter medications**, except those listed on the medication form.
- **Folding chairs**, with the exception of cane-chair and seat-walker mobility aids
- **Glass containers**
- **Costumes** on Guests 14 years of age or older
- **Water pistols, toy guns and replica weapons**, with the exception of those sold in the Disneyland® Resort
- **Sporting goods or equipment** (e.g., baseball bats, helmets, hockey sticks, golf clubs, bows and arrows, camping equipment, chairs, stools, tables and Frisbees)
- **Weapons of any kind** (including guns, knives, billy clubs, brass knuckles, nunchucks, stars and other martial arts equipment)
- **Self-defense equipment** (pepper spray, mace, stun guns)
- **Restraining devices** (e.g., handcuffs, zip ties) or any suspicious items (e.g., box cutters, razor blades, duct tape, wire)
- **Remote control toys**
- **Drones**
- **Items that may be disruptive** (e.g., laser pointers, slingshots, stink bombs, air horns)
- **Selfie sticks** (hand-held extension poles for cameras and mobile devices)
- **Miscellaneous other items** (tools, fire extinguishers, musical instruments, megaphones)
- **Professional cameras**, except folding tripod stands that can fit inside a standard backpack
- **Weapons or accessories** that appear to be weapons (e.g., bullet belts)
- **Sharp or pointed accessories** that may cause injury
- **Masks** or makeup that could be construed as part of a costume
- **Tobacco products** including electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes) and vaping products
- **Markers** of any type

The signatures below are **REQUIRED** to attend the Citrus Valley High School 2017 Disney Grad Night trip. This form **MUST** be completed and turned in to purchase a ticket.

I, _____, as parent/legal guardian for my son/daughter, _____, hereby give permission for him/her to participate in the Citrus Valley High School 2017 Disneyland Grad Night trip. My son/daughter and I understand that (s)he assumes full responsibility for his/her own actions and shares responsibility for the group's actions. If needed because of emergency, I hereby legally authorize the trip chaperones to authorize any medical services that my child might require. I have listed on the Special Needs & Medication form any prescriptive medicine that my child will have with him/her on the trip.

****If special arrangements are needed for your child, please list them on the Special Needs & Medication form.**

My son/daughter and I further understand that (s)he must abide by all rules and regulations set forth by the Grad Night Committee, trip chaperones, bus drivers, Disneyland, California Adventure, etc. If any of these rules (partial listing below) are broken, the Grad may be sent home at his/her own expense without refund and the parent/legal guardian will be advised that they will arrange for transportation home at their own expense and will hold Redlands Unified School District, Citrus Valley High School, and the CVHS PTSA 2017 Grad Night Committee harmless of any liability.

Following are some of the rules and regulations of this trip, which are to be adhered to by all Grads at all times:

- 1. Identification:** All students will be required to show proper/valid photo identification upon boarding the bus.
- 2. Alcohol and Drugs:** It is illegal for Grad to be in possession of or under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. A Grad found under the influence or in possession of alcohol and/or drugs will be immediately expelled from the trip without refund. Notification regarding prescription drugs must be listed on the back of Medication Form and the medication presented to the lead chaperone/Grad Night committee member prior to departure. (Please note that a Grad's personal belongings may be searched for alcohol and/or drugs at any time). There will be zero tolerance of illegal substances of any kind.
- 3. Grads are responsible for being on time for check-in times and departures.** If Grads are excessively late for a departure (more than 15 minutes) they may be left behind and the parent/legal guardian will be notified and it will be their responsibility to find transportation home for the Grad(s).
- 4. Unacceptable Conduct:** Excessive rowdiness, fighting, damaging of property, foul language, and any illegal act(s) including stealing or shoplifting, and not following chaperone rules is prohibited. Grads are expected to act in a socially acceptable manner deemed normal by civilized society.
- 5. Dress Code:** Grads are expected to abide by the Disney dress code as outlined in this packet of information. Any article of clothing deemed vulgar, offensive, or inappropriate by chaperones will not be allowed at any time while on this trip.
